December 24 - December 26th - CLOSED

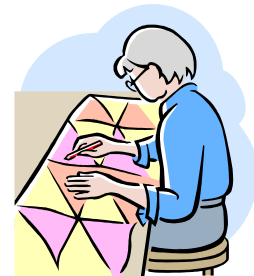
December 27, 28, 29th Hours are 11 - 4p.m.

December 31st - January 1st - CLOSED

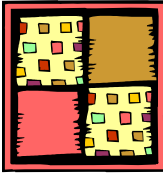


Our **new class schedule** will be out on December 20th. Please drop into the store or check the website for more information.
