

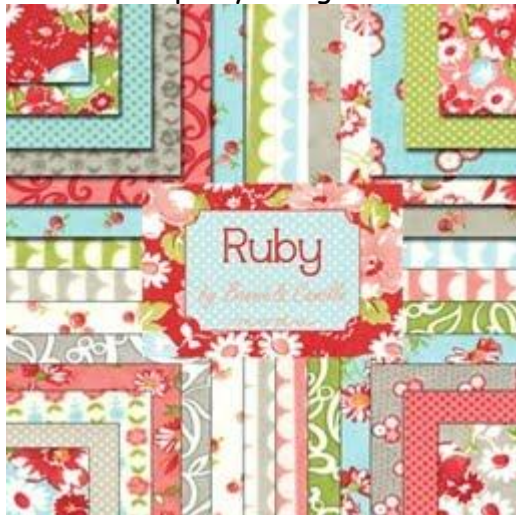
QuiltE-news
